Academics

The development of fundamental intellectual and communication skills that allow critical thinking and independent judgment is one of the main objectives of Pingry's academic programs. From the earliest ages, students are also taught the importance of personal integrity, self-discipline, respect for others, and appreciation of traditional values.



Fine Arts

At all levels, Visual Arts, Drama, and Music provide valuable and unique learning experiences that develop aesthetic insights and encourage creative risk-taking. Each discipline promotes the development of a sense of self, as well as engagement with the community and the world through creative problem solving and collaboration.



Athletics

The Pingry School has a longstanding tradition of emphasizing the important relationship between a healthy and active body and a healthy and active mind. Through physical education and an Athletic Department that fields nearly 80 teams in 20 different sports, students learn the value of teamwork, loyalty, sportsmanship, and grace under pressure.



The Pingry Honor Code

The Pingry experience is based on mutual respect and personal integrity. The foundation of this belief is Pingry's Honor Code, which, since 1926, has set the ethical standard that underlies every dimension of school life.

Pingry believes that students should understand and live by standards of honorable behavior, which are essentially a matter of attitude and spirit rather than a system of rules and regulations.

Decent, self-respecting behavior must be based on personal integrity and genuine concern for others and on the ethical principles which are the basis of civilized society.


Our Collaborative Faculty and Staff Will Support You On Your Journey.

The Pingry School has 160 full- and part-time faculty members, more than sixty percent of whom hold master's degrees or doctorates. This close-knit community includes teachers ranging from those new to the profession to seasoned veterans. The faculty mirrors The Pingry School's commitment to intellectual engagement, student centered learning, inclusion, diversity, and respect. Mentor programs help new faculty members take advantage of the resources Pingry makes available.

Professional Development and Faculty Recognition

Coaching and Mentoring

Every faculty member, during his or her first year at Pingry, is paired with another teacher who acts as a coach to help with the transition to the community and understanding the school's culture. In their second year at Pingry, teachers join the mentoring program to receive guidance from a master teacher about the most effective ways to deliver the curriculum. Mentoring and coaching also foster a strong sense of community.



Continuing Education

All faculty members are expected to engage in professional development activities to ensure that they remain at the forefront of their disciplines and profession. Other development activities include Summer Fellowships, which encourage faculty members to push their academic/teaching passions in new directions. The Global Programs initiative offers overseas opportunities, also intended to provide fresh academic perspectives.




Country Day Philosophy
