Families must complete and submit the Admission Application online. Our online application can be found at [Pingry.org](http://Pingry.org) within the Admission Section. Grades K-5 applications must be received by Wednesday, December 19, 2018. Grades 6-11 applications must be received by Wednesday, January 2, 2019.

For your reference, we have listed the short answer questions that parent(s)/guardian(s) and the applicant will need to complete within the online application. Applicants to our Middle and Upper School will also complete an Activities Questionnaire.

We realize that families, especially students completing the Middle and Upper School Application and Activities Questionnaires, want to be thoughtful in answering our questions. As an office, we look forward to reading your replies and encourage you to have fun crafting your answers.

### Middle School (6-8) Applicant Questionnaire
